Soak your chalk in a bowl of water. Use the tape to create a cross shape on your paper. Encourage the kiddos to use the wet chalk to paint/color colorful designs on their paper.

Wet chalk has a consistency similar to paint and the colors will appear richer and deeper than dry chalk. You kids will be intrigued when it glides smoothly across the paper leaving a beautiful thick paste.

## **Easy Cross Craft for Kids**









## **Materials Needed:**

- Colored Chalk ~ We used sidewalk chalk
- Water
- Painters Tape
- Sturdy paper

Soak your chalk in a bowl of water. Use the tape to create a cross shape on your paper. Encourage the kiddos to use the wet chalk to paint/color colorful designs on their paper.

Wet chalk has a consistency similar to paint and the colors will appear richer and deeper than dry chalk. You kids will be intrigued when it glides smoothly across the paper leaving a beautiful thick paste.

Allow the chalk and paper to dry before gently removing the tape. Wet paper rips easily, so try to remove the tape slowly to minimize and tearing.
